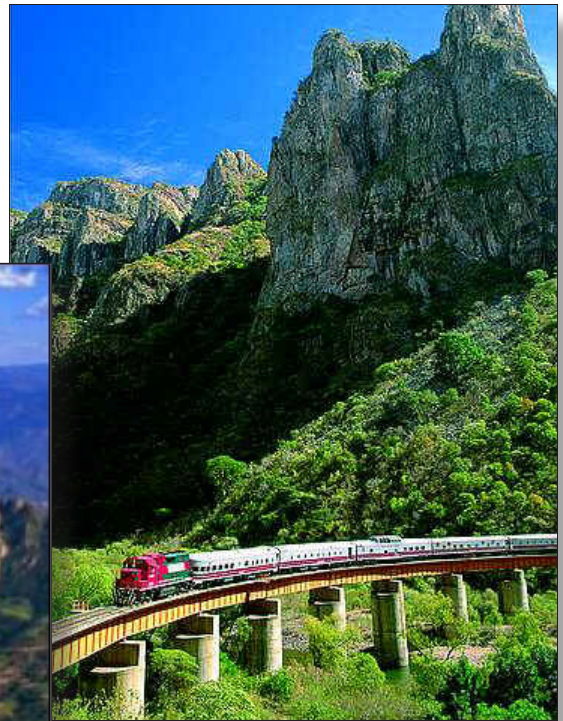
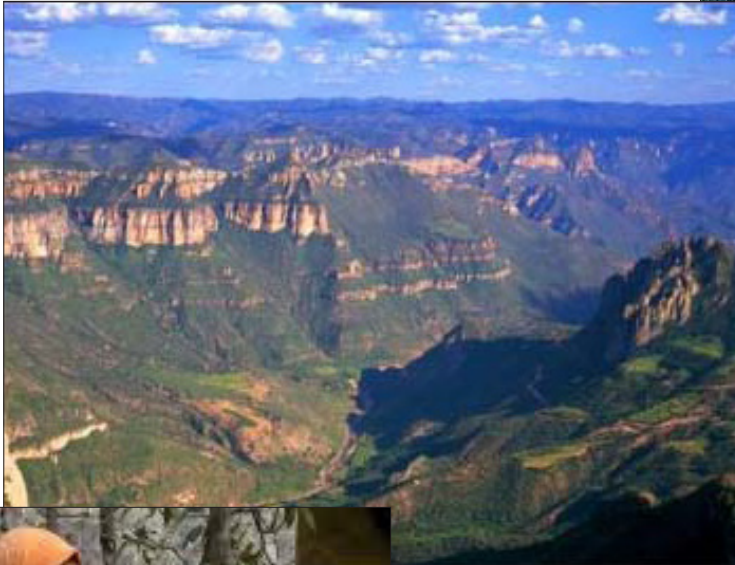


# Copper Canyon Mexico
