Winner of the International Award for Journalism in Mexico (2009), Eva Golinger is a Venezuelan-American attorney from New York, living in Caracas, Venezuela since 2005. She is the author of several best-selling books, including *The Chávez Code: Cracking US*

Intervention in Venezuela (2006), *Bush vs. Chávez: Washington's War on Venezuela* (2007), and *The Empire's Web: Encyclopedia of Interventionism and Subversion* (2008). Since 2003 Eva has been investigating, analyzing and writing about US intervention in Venezuela using the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) to obtain information about the US Government's efforts to destabilize progressive movements in Latin America. Her first book, *The Chávez Code*, is presently being made into a feature film.
