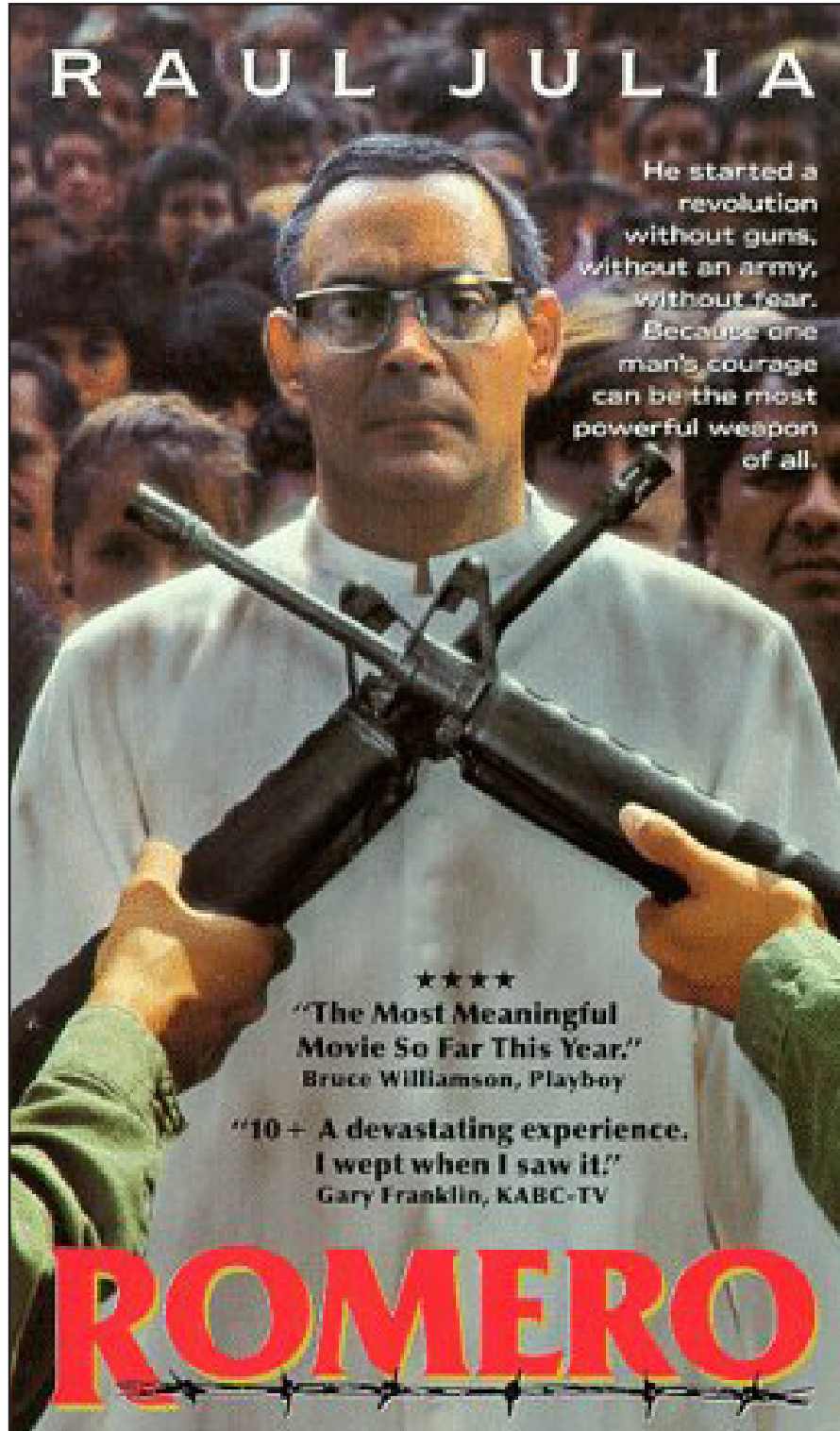


Commemorating the 30th Anniversary of the Assassination of Archbishop Oscar Romero,
