

The Task Force on the Americas Presents



This award-winning documentary about human rights abuses in Guatemala is narrated by Rigoberta Menchú, winner of the 1992 Nobel Peace Prize for her courageous struggle against the military regime in her country. It contains some of the first footage documenting the previously unreported war waged by the Guatemalan military against the Mayan population in the 80s.

The film is directed by Newton Thomas Sigel and Pamela Yates (who also directed *Granito: How to Nail a Dictator*, which was screened at this year's Mill Valley Film Festival).

Following the film, a speaker will give an update on recent arrests and trials of the members of the high command of the Guatemalan military and the results of the presidential election runoff.
